Shallow Subsidy provides 2+ years of rental assistance and community based services to those who have served our country.

Benefits of working with SSVF:

- Payment of 50% of the rent directly covered by SSVF financial assistance
- Community based services provided to veteran households for 2+ years!
- A dedicated contact on our team for landlords to call

What are community based services:

- Regularly scheduled meetings will be held in the unit
- Promote positive tenancy
- Monthly financial counseling
- Routine landlord communication

Our Veterans may be:

- Employed, seeking employment, or are in school -- elderly or disabled on a fixed income -- eligible to receive section 8

Phoelix is a Veteran of the Army who saw the end of the Cold War and the start of Desert Storm. While staying in a hotel during COVID, Phoelix was introduced to the Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) program of Pathways Vermont. About experiencing chronic homelessness Phoelix recalled, *“When you’re homeless you have no foundation to stand up on. One of the biggest barriers was just finding affordable housing. It all felt impossible.”*

The couple worked with Pathways team member Stacia to secure permanent housing and move out of their hotel room. After moving into their new home, Phoelix and Victoria are now looking forward to securing employment and settling into their apartment. They both shared, *“It’s just so nice to have our own place. We actually have privacy. We are excited to get furniture, curtains, and decorations!”*
